The Flow Blood circulation is a continuous cycle that begins with the heart pumping oxygenrich blood from the left ventricle into the aorta the bodys largest artery The aorta branches into smaller arteries that deliver blood to various organs and tissues As blood reaches the capillaries oxygen and nutrients are exchanged for carbon dioxide and waste products The deoxygenated blood then flows into veins which converge to form larger veins that return 2 blood to the hearts right atrium The heart then pumps this deoxygenated blood to the lungs where it picks up oxygen and releases carbon dioxide before returning to the left atrium to begin the cycle again

Regulating the Flow The circulatory system operates under precise regulation to ensure optimal blood flow to all parts of the body This regulation involves

Blood pressure The force exerted by blood against the walls of blood vessels

Heart rate The number of times the heart beats per minute

Blood vessel diameter Constriction or dilation of blood vessels affects blood flow and pressure
