in my office i am encased in bookshelves which hold an accumulation of literature on ecology that represents the papers and books over the last 50 years my students enjoy rummaging through this collection because it contains a record of the history of ecology and is full of surprises some of the most recent material pertains to landscape ecology a subject that literally emerged fully active at the veldhoven international congress organized by the landscape ecologists of the netherlands in 1981 the subject has developed quickly it has one or more journals which publish short works it has a series of text books and it has just begun a series on monographs one of the textbooks in landscape ecology is titled principles and methods in landscape ecology and was written by the italian ecologist almo farina in 1998 my students like this text especially well because it is direct to the point and comprehensive farina is on loan much of the time in the present volume almo farina again addresses the subject of landscape
